

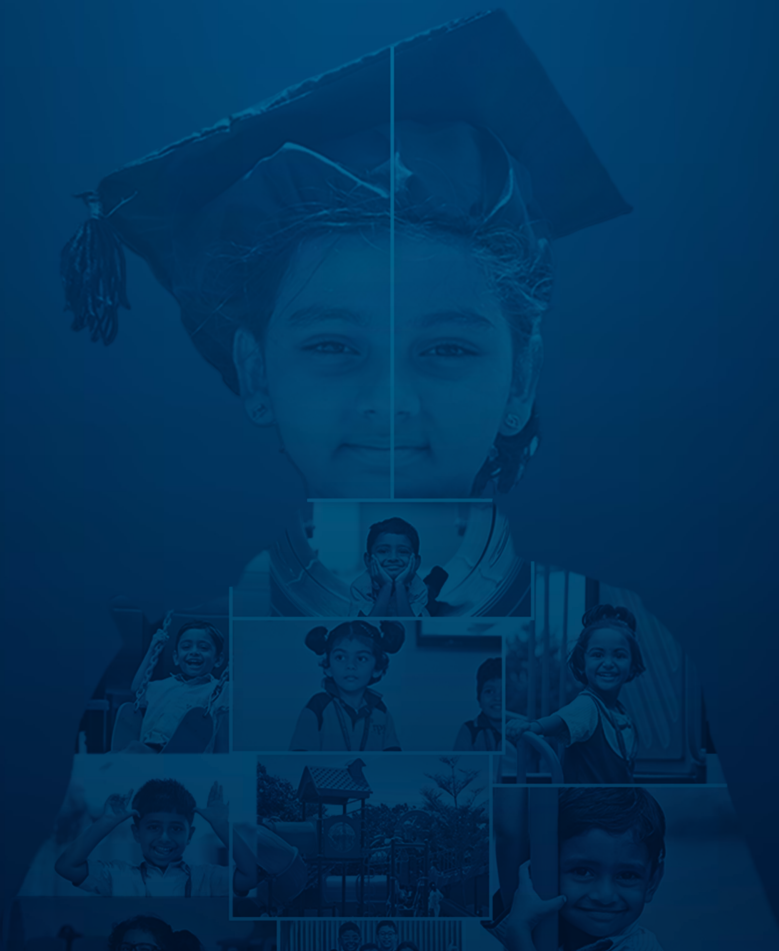

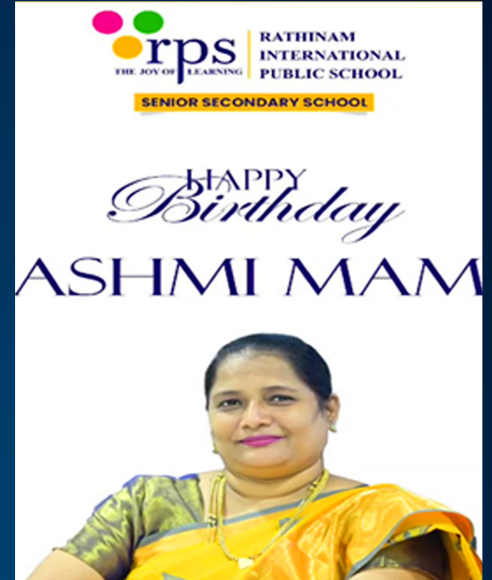

MATH AND SCIENCE EXPO @ RPS



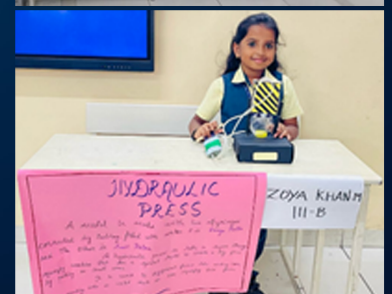

"INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY"

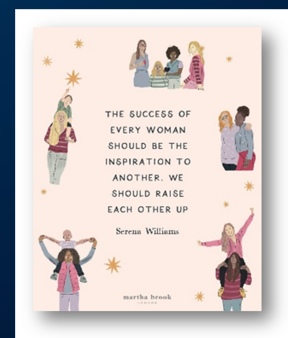

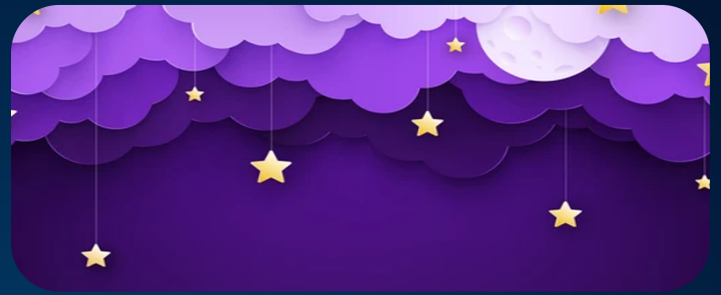
